- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-10-71 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to fleeing or attempting to elude a peace officer; and to provide a penalty.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 39-10-71 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **39-10-71.** Fleeing or attempting to elude a peace officer - Penalty.

- Any<u>A</u> driver of a motor vehicle who willfully fails or refuses to bring the vehicle to a
 stop, or who otherwise flees or attempts to elude, in any manner, a pursuing police
 vehicle or peace officer, when given a visual or audible signal to bring the vehicle to a
 stop, is guilty of a class:
- 11a.Class A misdemeanor for a first offense and a class C felony for a subsequent12offense within three years. An individual who violates this section while fleeing-13after or in the commission of a felony is guilty of a class;
- 14 <u>b.</u> <u>Class</u> C felony- <u>if the driver violates this section while willfully fleeing during or</u>
 15 <u>after the commission of a felony; or</u>
- 16 <u>c.</u> <u>Class C felony if, at any time during the flight or pursuit, the driver willfully</u>
 17 <u>operates the vehicle in a manner constituting an inherent risk of death or serious</u>
 18 <u>bodily injury to a third person.</u>
- 19 2. A signal complies with this section if the signal is perceptible to the driver and:
- a. If given from a vehicle, the signal is given by hand, voice, emergency light, or
 siren, and the stopping vehicle is appropriately marked showing it to be an official
 police vehicle; or

- 1 b. If not given from a vehicle, the signal is given by hand, voice, emergency light, or
- 2 siren, and the officer is in uniform or prominently displays the officer's badge of
- 3 office.
