- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15.1-07-20 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to mandatory safety training for school bus drivers.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 15.1-07-20 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 15.1-07-20. School vehicle driver Requirements.
- a. Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, if an individual transports
 students or other passengers in a school vehicle for which a commercial driver's
 license is not required, the individual must:
 - (1) Hold a North Dakota driver's license;
 - (2) Be free from communicable diseases;
 - (3) Be in good physical health and have normal use of both hands, both feet, both eyes, and both ears;
- 14 (4) Be of sound mental health;
- 15 (5) Pass any drug and alcohol screening tests required by the school board; 16 and
 - (6) Be at least twenty-one years of age, unless the board of a school district determines that an individual not meeting this requirement can safely and adequately perform the required duties; and
 - (7) Complete the national safety council defensive driving course number four workshop within the first year of employment and at least once every five years thereafter.
 - b. If the vehicle being used to transport students or other passengers under this subsection is a school vehicle for which a commercial driver's license is not
