- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 2 of section 39-06.1-06 and section
- 2 39-21-41.4 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the amount of statutory fees and the
- 3 use of safety belts; to repeal section 39-21-41.5 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to
- 4 secondary enforcement of safety belt requirements; and to provide a penalty.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 2 of section 39-06.1-06 of the North Dakota
  Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 8 2. For a moving violation as defined in section 39-06.1-09, a fee of twenty dollars, except for:
- a. A violation of section 39-10-26, 39-10-26.2, 39-10-41, or 39-10-42, or 39-21-41.4,
  a fee of fifty dollars.
- b. A violation of section 39-10-05 involving failure to yield to a pedestrian or
  subsection 1 of section 39-10-28, a fee of fifty dollars.
- 14 c. A violation of section 39-21-41.2, a fee of twenty-five dollars.
- d. A violation of subsection 1 of section 39-12-02, section 39-08-23, or section
  39-08-25, a fee of one hundred dollars.
- e. A violation of subdivision d of subsection 1 of section 39-12-04, a fee of one hundred dollars.
- f. A violation of subsection 1 of section 39-04-37 by an individual by becoming a resident of this state, a fee of one hundred dollars.
- g. A violation of subsection 2 of section 39-10-21.1, a fee of two hundred fifty dollars.
- h. A violation of section 39-10-59, a fee of five hundred dollars.
- i. A violation of section 39-09-01, a fee of thirty dollars.

1		j.	A violation of section 39-09-01.1, a fee of thirty dollars.
2		k.	A violation of section 39-10-46 or 39-10-46.1, a fee of one hundred dollars.
3		I.	A violation of subsection 1 of section 39-08-20, one hundred fifty dollars for a first
4			violation and three hundred dollars for a second or subsequent violation in three
5			years.
6	SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 39-21-41.4 of the North Dakota Century Code is		
7	amended and reenacted as follows:		
8	39-21-41.4. Use of safety belts required in certain motor vehicles - Enforcement -

10	Subject to the limitations of this section and section 39-21-41.5, a

13		eac	h front seat occupant is wearing a properly adjusted and fastened safety belt.

15		<u>a.</u>	$\underline{\text{To}}$ a child in a child restraint or safety belt in accordance with section 39-21-41.2;

17		<u>b.</u>	To a driver of implements of husbandry; to operators
18		<u>C.</u>	To an operator of farm vehicles as defined in subsection 5 of section 39-04-19; to
19		<u>d.</u>	To rural mail carriers while on duty delivering mail; to
20		<u>e.</u>	To an occupant with a medical or physically disabling condition that prevents
21			appropriate restraint in a safety belt, if a qualified physician, physician assistant,
22			or advanced practice registered nurse states in a signed writing the nature of the
23			condition and the reason restraint is inappropriate; or when
24		<u>f.</u>	When all front seat safety belts are in use by other occupants; or
25		<u>g.</u>	To an operator or a passenger of a motor vehicle that stops frequently to allow
26			the driver or passenger to leave the vehicle temporarily or to deliver property
27			from the vehicle. This exception applies only when the vehicle is traveling at a
28			speed not exceeding thirty miles [48.28 kilometers] per hour between stops.
29	3. A physician, physician assistant, or advanced practice registered nurse who, in good		
30		faith	n, provides a statement that restraint would be inappropriate is not subject to civil
31	liability.

- 4. A violation for not wearing a safety belt under this section is not, in itself, evidence of
  negligence. The fact of a violation of this section is not admissible in any proceeding
  other than one charging the violation.
- 4 **SECTION 3. REPEAL.** Section 39-21-41.5 of the North Dakota Century Code is repealed.
