1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 12.1-01-05 and 39-06.1-06, and subsection 2

2 of section 40-05-06 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the effect of state law on city

3 or county ordinances and to statutory fees for noncriminal traffic offenses; and to provide a

4 penalty.

### 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 12.1-01-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is

7 amended and reenacted as follows:

## 8 12.1-01-05. Crimes defined by state law shallmay not be superseded by city or county

9 ordinance or by home rule city's or county's charter or ordinance.

10 NoExcept as provided in section 40-05-06, an offense defined in this title or elsewhere by

11 law shall<u>may not</u> be superseded by any city or county ordinance, or city or county home rule

12 charter, or by an ordinance adopted pursuant to such a charter, and all such offense definitions

13 shall have full force and effect within the territorial limits and other jurisdiction of home rule cities

14 or counties. This section shall<u>does</u> not preclude any city or county from enacting any ordinance

15 containing penal language when otherwise authorized to do so by law.

16 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 39-06.1-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is

17 amended and reenacted as follows:

## 18 **39-06.1-06. Amount of statutory fees.**

The fees required for a noncriminal disposition under section 39-06.1-02 or 39-06.1-03 mustbe as follows:

- 21 1. For a nonmoving violation as defined in section 39-06.1-08, a fee of twentyforty dollars
- 22 except for a violation of any traffic parking regulation on any state charitable or penal
- institution property or on the state capitol grounds, a fee in the amount of fiveten
- 24 dollars, excluding a violation of subsection 11 of section 39-01-15.

Except as provided in subsections 5 and 7, for a violation of section 39-09-02, or an 26 equivalent ordinance, a fee established as follows: 27 Miles per hour over 28 lawful speed limit Fee 29 1 - 5 \$ <del>5</del>10 30 6 - 10 \$ 510 plus \$1/each mph over 5 mph over limit 31 11 - 15 \$ 1020 plus \$1/each mph over 10 mph over limit

13	6.	For a violation of subsection 3 of section 39-21-46, a fee established as follows:
14		a. Driving more than eleven hours since the last ten hours off duty, driving after
15		fourteen hours on duty since the last ten hours off duty, driving after sixty hours
16		on duty in seven days or seventy hours in eight days, no record of duty status or
17		log book in possession, failing to retain previous seven-day record of duty status
18		or log book, or operating a vehicle with four to six out-of-service defects, onetwo
19		hundred dollars;
20		b. False record of duty status or log book or operating a vehicle with seven to nine
21		out-of-service defects, two hundred fiftyfive hundred dollars;
22		c. Operating a vehicle after driver placed out of service, operating a vehicle with ten
23		or more out-of-service defects, or operating a vehicle that has been placed out of
24		service prior to its repair, five hundredone thousand dollars; and
25		d. All other violations of motor carrier safety rules adopted under subsection 3 of
26		section 39-21-46, fiftyone hundred dollars.
27	7.	On a highway on which the speed limit is posted in excess of sixty-five miles
28		[104.61 kilometers] an hour, for a violation of section 39-09-02, or equivalent
29		ordinance, a fee of fiveten dollars for each mile per hour over the limit.
30	8.	For a violation of a school zone speed limit under subdivision b of subsection 1 of
31		section 39-09-02, a fee of fortyeighty dollars for one through ten miles per hour over

- the posted speed; and fortyeighty dollars, plus one dollartwo dollars for each
  additional mile per hour over ten miles per hour over the limit unless a greater fee
  would be applicable under this section.
- 4 For a violation of a highway construction zone speed limit under subsection 2 of 9. 5 section 39-09-02, a fee of eightyone hundred sixty dollars for one through ten miles 6 per hour over the posted speed; and eightyone hundred sixty dollars plus twofour 7 dollars for each mile per hour over ten miles per hour over the limit, unless a greater 8 fee would be applicable under this section. The fee in this subsection does not apply 9 to a highway construction zone unless individuals engaged in construction are present 10 at the time and place of the violation and the posted speed limit sign states "Minimum 11 Fee <del>\$80<u>\$160</u>".</del>

# SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Subsection 2 of section 40-05-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

- 14 2. For every violation of a city ordinance regulating that regulates the operation or
- 15 equipment of <u>a</u> motor <del>vehicles</del><u>vehicle</u> or <del>regulating</del><u>which</u> regulates</u> traffic, except those
- 16 ordinances listed in section 39-06.1-05, a fee may be established, by ordinance, which
- 17 may not exceed by one hundred percent the limits, limit for an equivalent
- 18 categoriescategory of violationsviolation, set forth in section 39-06.1-06.
