- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 25-04 and a new section to
- 2 chapter 50-06 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to program management for residents
- 3 of the life skills and transition center and regional crisis support services for individuals with an
- 4 intellectual or developmental disability; to amend and reenact subsection 4 of section 50-06-37
- 5 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the assessment of intellectual or developmental
- 6 disabilities; and to provide for a report to the legislative management.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 8 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 25-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
- 9 and enacted as follows:

10 **Program management for a resident.**

- 11 <u>The department shall ensure active program management is maintained for eligible</u>
- 12 individuals residing at the life skills and transition center.
- 13 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subsection 4 of section 50-06-37 of the North Dakota Century
- 14 Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 15 4. The department shall contract with a team of support intensity scale assessors by
- 16 September 1, 2011. The team shall begin assessing immediately the identified client-
- 17 pilot group identified by the consultant contracted in subsection 2.conduct the
- 18 <u>standardized assessment of eligible individuals residing at the life skills and transition</u>
 19 <u>center.</u>
- 20 **SECTION 3.** A new section to chapter 50-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is created

and enacted as follows:

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1 <u>Regional crisis support services for individuals with an intellectual or developmental</u>

- 2 disability.
- 3 The department shall establish regional crisis support services for individuals with an
- 4 intellectual or developmental disability. The regional crisis support services teams shall provide
- 5 timely crisis assistance to individuals with an intellectual or developmental disability.

6 SECTION 4. REPORT TO LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT - SYSTEM OF SERVICES FOR

7 INDIVIDUALS WITH AN INTELLECTUAL OR DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITY. The

- 8 department of human services shall provide the legislative management a status report on:
- 9 1. The ongoing work of the department to improve community provider capacity,
- 10 including any barriers encountered; and
- 1 2. The system of services for individuals with an intellectual or developmental disability,
- 12 including a review of the existing service system, funding, and unmet needs.
