4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - REPORTS TO ATTORNEY GENERAL, LEGISLATIVE
6	ASSEMBLY, AND LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT. There is appropriated out of any moneys in
7	the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$1,500,000, or so
8	much of the sum as may be necessary, to the attorney general for the purpose of providing
9	grants to organizations involved in providing prevention and treatment services related to
0	human trafficking victims for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021.
11	The attorney general may provide grants for the development and implementation of direct care
2	emergency or long-term crisis services, residential care, training for law enforcement, support of
3	advocacy services, and programs promoting positive outcomes for victims. Any organization
4	that receives a grant under this section shall report to the attorney general and the
5	appropriations committees of the sixty-seventh legislative assembly on the use of the funds
6	received and the outcomes of its program. The attorney general shall report to the legislative
7	management during the 2019-20 interim on the status and results of the grant program.
