1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 57-02-51, 57-09-01, and 57-11-01 of the North

2 Dakota Century Code, relating to the meeting of the board of equalization of <u>a township and a</u>

3 city.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 57-02-51 of the North Dakota Century Code is

6 amended and reenacted as follows:

57-02-51. Notice of township and city equalization meetings to be published - Date of
equalization meeting.

9 Each year the county auditor shall publish in the official county newspaper for two 10 successive weeks, a notice that proceedings for the equalization of assessments will be held by 11 the several local equalization boards. The first publication of the notice may not be earlier than 12 March first and the second publication may not be later than March twentieth. The notice must 13 contain a statement that the proceedings will be held at the regular meeting place of the 14 governing board or other place designated by that board of the township or city, as the case 15 may be. The notice must also contain a statement that each taxpayer has the right to appear 16 before the appropriate board of review or equalization and petition for correction of the 17 taxpayer's assessment. The equalization proceedings in an organized township and a city must 18 be held on the second Monday in April and in a city on the second Tuesday inwithin the first. 19 fifteen days of April. 20 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 57-09-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is 21 amended and reenacted as follows: 22 57-09-01. Membership of board - Meeting.

The township board of equalization consists of the members of the board of
 supervisors of each township, and the township clerk shall act as clerk of said board.

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1		The board shall meet on the second Monday inwithin the first fifteen days of April in
2	1	each year at the usual place of meeting of the township board of supervisors.
3	2.	Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 1, if lf the same person performs the
4		duties of assessor for two or more townships or cities, the township clerk may, after
5		consultation with the assessor involved, designate the hour and day in the month of
6		April at which the meeting provided for in subsection 1 must be held for each township
7		board of equalization; provided, that notice of the hour and day must be published in
8		the official newspaper of the political subdivisions involved and posted at the usual
9		place of meeting by the township clerk at least ten days before the meeting.
10	SEC	CTION 3. AMENDMENT. Section 57-11-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is
11	amende	ed and reenacted as follows:
12	57-11-01. Membership of board - Quorum - Meeting.	
13	1.	The board of equalization of a city consists of the members of the governing body, and
14		shall meet at the usual place of meeting of the governing body of the city, on the
15		second Tuesday in April in <u>within the first fifteen days of April of</u> each year. The
16		executive officer of the governing body shall act as chairman, but in the executive
17		officer's absence the governing body may elect one of its members to preside. A
18		majority of the board constitutes a quorum to transact business, and it may adjourn
19		from day to day until its work is completed. In caseIf a quorum is not present at any
20		time, the clerk may adjourn from day to day and publicly announce the time to which
21	I	the meeting is adjourned.
22	2.	Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 1, if lf the same person performs the
23		duties of assessor for two or more cities or townships, the city auditor may, after
24		consultation with the assessor involved, designate the hour and day in the month of
25		April at which the meeting provided for in subsection 1 must be held for each city
26		board of equalization; provided, that notice of the hour and day must be published in
27		the official newspaper of the political subdivisions involved and posted at the usual
28		place of meeting by the city auditor at least ten days before the meeting.
