- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 14-09-00.1 and subsection 1 of section
- 2 14-09-29 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to shared parenting time and
- 3 responsibility.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 14-09-00.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is

6 amended and reenacted as follows:

7 **14-09-00.1.** Definitions.

- 8 As used in this chapter, unless the context otherwise requires:
- 9 1. "Decisionmaking responsibility" means the responsibility to make decisions concerning
 10 the child. The term may refer to decisions on all issues or on specified issues, but not
 11 child support issues.
- 12 2. "Equal residential responsibility" means each parent has residential responsibility for
 13 the child for an equal amount of time as determined by the court.
- 14 <u>3. "Extended parenting time" means parenting time between a child and a parent</u>
 15 <u>scheduled by court order to exceed an annual total of 100 overnights.</u>
- 16 2.4. "Parental rights and responsibilities" means all rights and responsibilities a parent has
 17 concerning the parent's child.
- 18 3.5. "Parenting plan" means a written plan describing each parent's rights and
 19 responsibilities.
- 20 4.6. "Parenting schedule" means the schedule of when the child is in the care of each
 21 parent.
- 22 **5**.7. "Parenting time" means the time when the child is to be in the care of a parent.
- ^{6.8.} "Primary residential responsibility" means a parent with more than fifty percent of the
 residential responsibility.

9	1.	<u>a.</u>	A court issuing an order that deals with parenting rights and responsibilities of a	
10			child entered under this chapter shall award the parental rights and	
11			responsibilities concerning the child to a person, agency, organization, or	
12			institution as will, in the opinion of the court, promote the best interests and	
13			welfare of the child.	
14		<u>b.</u>	Between the mother and father, whether married or unmarried, there is no	
15			presumption as to whom will better promote the best interests and welfare of the	
16			child.	
17		<u>C.</u>	In any proceeding to establish or modify a judgment for providing for parenting	
18			time and residential responsibility and subject to the requirements of section	
19			14-09-06.6, if one party has requested shared parenting time and or equal	
20			residential responsibility, the court shall consider awarding shared parenting time	
21			and or equalresidential responsibility and shall articulate in its decision its	
22			rationale for either awarding or denying the request for shared parenting time	
23			andor equal residential responsibility.
