- 2 relating to payments for school bus driver physical examinations.

6 **15.1-07-20. School vehicle driver - Requirements.**

- 7 1. a. Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, if an individual transports
 8 students or other passengers in a school vehicle for which a commercial driver's
 9 license is not required, the individual must:
- 10 (1) Hold a North Dakota driver's license;
 - (2) Be free from communicable diseases;
 - (3) Be in good physical health and have normal use of both hands, both feet, both eyes, and both ears;
 - (4) Be of sound mental health;
- 15 (5) Pass any drug and alcohol screening tests required by the school board;16 and
- 17 (6) Be at least twenty-one years of age, unless the board of a school district
 18 determines that an individual not meeting this requirement can safely and
 19 adequately perform the required duties.
- 20b.If the vehicle being used to transport students or other passengers under this21subsection is a school vehicle for which a commercial driver's license is not22required, but which is designed to seat ten to fifteen passengers, the individual23must:
