- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 3 of section 50-24.6-04 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to prior authorization for medical assistance.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 3 of section 50-24.6-04 of the North Dakota 5 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
  - 3. a. For individuals twenty-one years of age and older, except for quantity limits that may be no less than the pharmaceutical manufacturer's package insert, brand name drugs with a generic equivalent drug for which the cost to the state postrebate is less than the brand name drugs, in the aggregate, or generic drugs with a brand name equivalent drug for which the cost to the state postrebate is less than the generic drug, the department may not prior authorize the following medication classes:
    - (1) Antipsychotics;
      - (2) Antidepressants;

- 16 (4) Antiretrovirals, for the treatment of human immunodeficiency virus; and
- 17 (5) Antineoplastic agents, for the treatment of cancer; and
  - (6) Stimulant medication used for the treatment of attention deficit disorder and attention deficit hyperactivity disorder.

For individuals under twenty-one years of age, except for quantity limits that may be no less than the pharmaceutical manufacturer's package insert, brand name drugs with a generic equivalent drug for which the cost to the state postrebate is less than the brand name drugs, in the aggregate, or generic drugs with a brand name equivalent drug for which the cost to the state postrebate is less than the
