- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 50-06 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to peer support specialist certification; and to provide an appropriation.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 50-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
- 5 and enacted as follows:
- 6 Peer support specialist certification.
- 7 The behavioral health division shall establish and implement a program for the certification
- 8 of peer support specialists. In developing the program, the division shall:
- 9 <u>1. Define a peer support specialist;</u>
- 10 2. Establish eligibility requirements for certification;
- 11 <u>3.</u> Establish application procedures and standards for the approval or disapproval of
- 12 <u>applications for certification;</u>
- 13 <u>4. Enter reciprocity agreements with other states as deemed appropriate to certify</u>
- 14 <u>nonresident applicants registered under the laws of other states having requirements</u>
- 15 <u>for peer support specialists; and</u>
- 16 5. Establish continuing education and certification renewal requirements.
- 17 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general
- 18 fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$275,000, or so much of the
- sum as may be necessary, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income,
- 20 the sum of \$275,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of human
- 21 services for the purpose of establishing and implementing a peer support specialist certification
- program, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021. The department
- 23 of human services is authorized one full-time equivalent position for this purpose.
