- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-12 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the expansion of existing school safety and crisis reporting programs;
- 3 and to provide for a continuing appropriation.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 54-12 of the North Dakota Century Code is created

6 and enacted as follows:

School safety and crisis reporting programs - Confidentiality of records - Continuing appropriation.

- 9 <u>1.</u> The attorney general shall encourage and promote the use of statewide and
- 10 <u>locally-selected school safety and crisis reporting programs.</u>
- 11 <u>2.</u> <u>If funding becomes available, the attorney general may:</u>
- 12 <u>a.</u> Expand a statewide program to include tailored reporting mechanisms targeted to
 13 <u>incidents of bullying and physical or sexual abuse; and</u>
- 14b.Conduct outreach to promote awareness of statewide or locally-selected school15safety and crisis reporting programs.
- All records or information related to the operation of the programs described in
 subsection 1 are exempt records as defined in section 44-04-18.1.
- 18 <u>4.</u> <u>The attorney general may seek and accept gifts, grants, and donations from any</u>
- 19 source for the purpose of carrying out its duties under this section. All moneys
- 20 received as gifts, grants, and donations are appropriated to the attorney general on a
- 21 <u>continuing basis for the purpose of carrying out this section.</u>
- 5. The attorney general may adopt rules necessary to administer the duties required to
 carry out this section.
