- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the department of
- 2 commerce; to provide exemptions; and to provide for a transfer.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the department of commerce for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the department of commerce, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021, as follows:

14	SECTION 3. EXEMPTION. The amount appropriated for the agricultural products utilization					
15	commission in section 1 of chapter 43 of the 2017 Session Laws is not subject to section					
16	54-44.1-11 and any unexpended funds from this line item for grants are available for grants					
17	during the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021.					
18	SECTION 4. EXEMPTION. The amount appropriated for the discretionary funds line item in					
19	section 1 of chapter 43 of the 2017 Session Laws is not subject to section 54-44.1-11 and any					
20	unexpended funds from this line item for grants are available for grants during the biennium					
21	beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021.					
22	SECTION 5. TRANSFER - INTERNSHIP FUND. The office of management and budget					
23	shall transfer \$950,000 of the amount appropriated in the operating expenses line item in					
24	section 1 of this Act to the internship fund for the purpose of administering the operation intern					
25	program, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021.					
26	SECTION 6. TRADE OFFICE - MATCHING FUND REQUIREMENT. The North Dakota					
27	trade office line item and the general fund appropriation in section 1 of this Act include					
28	\$2,000,000 of funding relating to the North Dakota trade office. The department of commerce					
29	may spend sixty percent of this amount without requiring any matching funds from the trade					
30	office. Any additional amounts may be spent only to the extent the North Dakota trade office					
31	provides one dollar of matching funds from private or other public sources for each one dollar					

- 1 provided by the department for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021.
- 2 Matching funds may include money spent by businesses or organizations to pay salaries to
- 3 export assistants, provide training to export assistants, or buy computer equipment as part of
- 4 the North Dakota trade office's export assistance program.

5 SECTION 7. ENTREPRENEURSHIP GRANTS AND VOUCHER PROGRAM -

- 6 **EXEMPTION.** Section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$1,950,000, of which \$600,000 is from
- 7 the general fund and \$1,350,000 is from special funds, for an entrepreneurship grants and
- 8 voucher program to be developed and administered by the department of commerce, for the
- 9 biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021. The department shall establish
- 10 guidelines to provide grants to entrepreneurial centers certified by the department. The
- 11 department also shall establish guidelines to award vouchers to entrepreneurs to procure
- 12 business development assistance from certified entrepreneurial centers or to provide grants to
- 13 entrepreneurs working with an entrepreneurial center. The amount appropriated for
- 14 entrepreneurship grants in section 1 of this Act is not subject to section 54-44.1-11 and any
- unexpended funds from this line item are available during the biennium beginning July 1, 2021,
- 16 and ending June 30, 2023.
