1 A BILL for an Act to require a legislative management study of the feasibility and desirability of

2 developing a school choice program.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - SCHOOL CHOICE PROGRAM.

- During the 2019-20 interim, the legislative management shall study the feasibility and
 desirability of developing a school choice program to provide parents of students with
 options, funding, and support in selecting charter schools, magnet schools, private
 schools, or home schooling for their children. The study must include:
- 9 a. The design, application, operations, and costs associated with the
 10 implementation of the program;
- b. Consideration of educational savings accounts, and may include other types of
 school choice programs; and
- c. A review of the best practices across the nation for similar programs and the
 associated requirements for guidance and monitoring of the program by the
 department of public instruction.
- The legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations, together
 with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-seventh
 legislative assembly.
