- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a legislative management study of state parks.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:
- 3 SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY STATE PARKS USE,
- 4 MANAGEMENT, OVERHEAD. During the 2019-20 interim, the legislative management shall
- 5 consider studying the purpose, value, and benefits of each state park. The study must include a
- 6 review of each state park's usage, annual attendance figures, and overhead, and the cost to
- 7 operate and maintain, and the market value of the land and structures of each state park. The
- 8 legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any
- 9 legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-seventh legislative
- 10 assembly.
