- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subdivision to subsection 2 of section 12-60-24,
- 2 and a new section to chapter 15.1-09 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to criminal-
- 3 history background checks and prohibiting felons from attaining membership on a school-
- 4 board for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15.1-09 of the North Dakota
- 5 Century Code, relating to public school board membership in a school district located on tribal
- 6 land; and to declare an emergency.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 8 **SECTION 1.** A new subdivision to subsection 2 of section 12-60-24 of the North Dakota 9 Century Code is created and enacted as follows: 10
 - The superintendent of public instruction for a school board candidate.
- 11 SECTION 2. A new section to chapter 15.1-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
- 12 and enacted as follows:
- 13 School board membership - Prohibition.
- 14 Notwithstanding section 12.1-33-02, an individual who has pled guilty to or has been
- 15 convicted of a felony, a crime against a child as defined under section 12.1-32-15, an offense
- 16 under chapter 12.1-23, a violation of a protection order under section 14-07.1-06, or an
- 17 equivalent offense of another state or under federal law, may not be placed on the
- 18 ballot for, elected as a member of, or appointed to a school board. When a candidate files under
- 19 section 15.1-09-08 to seek election to a school board or before an individual is appointed to fill a
- 20 vacancy on a school board, the individual shall submit to and must pass, as determined by the
- 21 superintendent of public instruction, a statewide and nationwide criminal history record check.
- 22 The criminal history record check must be conducted in accordance with section 12-60-24.
- 23 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15.1-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
- 24 and enacted as follows:

1	School board membership - Prohibition.
2	If a tribal government has prescribed by tribal law or resolution qualifications for eligibility for
3	candidates for public office which are more restrictive than the laws of this state, the
4	qualifications of candidates for eligibility for membership of a public school board of a school
5	district located on tribal land may not be less restrictive than the qualifications for eligibility
6	prescribed by tribal law or resolution for public office. For purposes of this section, "tribal land"
7	means that portion of the land within the exterior boundaries of an Indian reservation which is
8	located in the state.
9	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY. This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
