- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 40-21-01 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to qualified electors in city elections.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 40-21-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **40-21-01. Qualified electors in** municipal<u>city</u> election - Restrictions.

- 7 <u>1.</u> Every resident of a municipalitycity and any resident of the extraterritorial zoning
- 8 jurisdiction of the city who is qualified to vote therein at general elections may vote at
 9 all municipalcity elections held therein. When by that city.
- <u>Except as provided in subsection 3, when</u> elections are held by wards or precincts, a personan individual may not vote in any place other than the ward or precinct of which
 the personindividual is a resident.
- 13 <u>3.</u> An individual who is a resident of the extraterritorial zoning jurisdiction of the city is
- 14 <u>entitled to vote in the ward or precinct to which that area of the jurisdiction has been</u>
- 15 <u>designated to vote by the governing body of the city.</u>
