- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-10 and a new section to
- 2 chapter 54-44.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the duty of the state auditor to
- 3 report consecutive audit findings and the reduction of agency appropriations by the office of
- 4 management and budget.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 54-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
 and enacted as follows:
- 8 Consecutive audit findings Report.
- 9 Within ninety days of the completion of a state agency audit, the state auditor shall notify
- 10 the legislative audit and fiscal review committee and the director of the budget of any significant
- 11 <u>audit findings that have been reported in two or more consecutive audits.</u>
- SECTION 2. A new section to chapter 54-44.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
- 13 and enacted as follows:
- Office of management and budget to reduce appropriations Audit findings Report

 to the legislative audit and fiscal review committee.
- 16 <u>1.</u> Within thirty days of notification from the state auditor that a state agency's audit report
- has contained the same significant audit finding in at least two consecutive audit
- reports, the office of management and budget shall reduce the agency's current
- biennial appropriation, proportionally by line item, as follows:
- 20 <u>a.</u> By one percent if the same finding is identified in three audit reports; or
- b. By two percent if the same finding is identified in four or more audit reports.
- 22 <u>The director of the budget shall report any appropriation reductions under this section</u>
- 23 <u>to the legislative audit and fiscal review committee.</u>
