BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 15-11-40 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as 7 follows:
- 8 15-11-40. State energy research center Report.
- The state energy research center at the university of North Dakota energy and
 environmental research center is created for the purpose of conducting exploratory,
 transformational, and innovative research that advances future energy opportunities
 and benefits the state's economy and environment through:
 - a. Exploratory research of technologies and methodologies that facilitate the prudent development, and clean and efficient use, of the state's energy resources;
 - <u>b.</u> Greater access to energy experts for timely scientific and engineering studies to support the state's interests; and
 - c. Education and outreach related to the state's energy resources.
 - 2. The state energy research center shall report all research activities and accomplishments biennially annually to the interim legislative energy development and transmission committee and to the industrial commission. Upon request, the state energy research center shall report all research activities and accomplishments to the appropriations committees of the legislative assembly.

3		<u>a.</u>	Select the research topics and projects to be pursued:
4		<u>b.</u>	Enter contracts or agreements with other North Dakota institutions of higher
5			education to support select research topics and projects;
6		<u>C.</u>	Enter contracts or agreements with federal, private, and nonprofit organizations
7			to carry out selected research topics and projects; and
8		<u>d.</u>	Accepting donations, grants, contributions, and gifts from any source to carry out
9			the selected research topics and projects.
10	4.	The	state energy research center may not conduct research or pursue projects that
11		will	result in the exploration, storage, treatment, or disposal of high-level radioactive

13	SECTION 2. Section 57-51.1-07.9 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and		
14	enacted as follows:		
15	57-51.1-07.9. State energy research center fund - Continuing appropriation.		
16	The state energy research center fund is a special fund in the state treasury. Before		
17	depositing oil and gas gross production tax and oil extraction tax revenues under section		
18	57-51.1-07.5, twoone percent of the revenues must be deposited monthly into the state energy		
19	research center fund, up to sixfive million dollars per biennium. All moneys deposited in the		
20	state energy research center fund and interest on all such moneys are appropriated on a		
21	continuing basis to the industrial commission for distribution to the state energy research center		
22	The state energy research center shall use the funds in accordance with section 15-11-40.		
23	SECTION 3. EXPIRATION DATE. This Act is effective through June 30, 2023, and after that		
24	date is ineffective.
