A BILL for an Act to create and enact two new sections a new section to chapter 25-04 and a new section to chapter 50-06 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the assessment of program management for residents of the life skills and transition center and regional crisis support services for individuals with an intellectual or developmental disability; and to amend and reenact sections 25-04-02.1 and 25-16-01 subsection 4 of section 50-06-37 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the licensure accreditation of life skills and transition center by the department of human services and assessment of intellectual or developmental disabilities; and to provide for a report to the legislative management study.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

10 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 25-04-02.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

25-04-02.1. Accreditation of life skills and transition center <u>- Licensure</u>.

- 1. The department of human services shall request appropriations and resources sufficient to ensure maintenance of the life skills and transition center's accreditation by the accreditation council on services for people with developmental disabilities and certification by the health care financing administration orand, if deemed necessary, by similar accrediting and certifying organizations and agencies possessing standards applicable to an individual with a developmental disability and disciplines needed to provide quality services to individuals served.
 - Upon a showing the life skills and transition center satisfies the requirements of licensure, the department of human services shall issue a license as required undersection 25-16-03.
- SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 25-16-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

1	25-16-01. Definitions.
2	In this chapter unless the context or subject matter otherwise requires:
3	1. "Department" means the department of human services.
4	2. "Treatment or care center" means an entity providing services to individuals with
5	developmental disabilities and licensed by the department to provide services. The
6	term includes the life skills and transition center.
7	SECTION 3. A new section to chapter 50-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
8	and enacted as follows:
9	Assessment of individuals with an intellectual disability.
10	The department shall establish and implement a standardized assessment tool such as the
11	American association on intellectual and developmental disabilities' supports intensity scale to
12	assess individuals with an intellectual disability who are served through the department,
13	including the life skills and transition center and the state hospital.
14	SECTION 2. A new section to chapter 25-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
15	and enacted as follows:
16	Program management for a resident.
17	The department shall assign a developmental disabilities program manager to each eligible
18	individual who resides at the life skills and transition center. The department shall ensure active
19	program management is maintained for eligible individuals residing at the life skills and
20	transition center.
21	SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Subsection 4 of section 50-06-37 of the North Dakota Century
22	Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
23	4. The department shall contract with a team of support intensity scale assessors by
24	September 1, 2011. The team shall begin assessing immediately the identified client
25	pilot group identified by the consultant contracted in subsection 2. <u>Assessments must</u>
26	be completed for all eligible individuals residing at the life skills and transition center
27	and for eligible individuals with intellectual or developmental disabilities in long-term
28	care facilities who wish to enter a less restrictive setting.
29	SECTION 4. A new section to chapter 50-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is created

Regional crisis support services for individuals with an intellectual or developmental disability.

The department shall establish regional crisis support services for individuals with an intellectual or developmental disability. Each regional crisis support services local team must include at least two individuals with available contracted support. The regional crisis support services teams shall provide timely one-on-one crisis assistance to individuals with an intellectual or developmental disability.

WITH AN INTELLECTUAL DISABILITY. During the 2019-20 interim, the legislative management shall consider studying the results of the standardized assessment of individuals with an intellectual disability. The study must consider which services, support, and funding are necessary to allow individuals with an intellectual disability to live in and remain in their community. The legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation necessary to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-seventh legislative assembly.

SECTION 5. REPORT TO LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT. The department of human services shall provide the legislative management a status report on:

- The ongoing work of the department to improve community provider capacity, including any barriers encountered; and
- 2. The system of services for individuals with an intellectual or developmental disability, including a review of the existing service system, funding, and unmet needs.
