- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15.1-27-04.1 of the North Dakota Century
- 2 Code, relating to state foundation aid payments to school districts.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 15.1-27-04.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 15.1-27-04.1. Baseline funding Establishment Determination of state aid.
- 7 1. To determine the amount of state aid payable to each district, the superintendent of public instruction shall establish each district's baseline funding. A district's baseline funding consists of:
- 10 a. All state aid received by the district in accordance with chapter 15.1-27 during the
 2012-13 school year;
 - b. The district's 2012-13 mill levy reduction grant, as determined in accordance with chapter 57-64, as it existed on June 30, 2013;
 - c. An amount equal to that raised by the district's 2012 general fund levy or that raised by one hundred ten mills of the district's 2012 general fund levy, whichever is less;
 - d. An amount equal to that raised by the district's 2012 long-distance learning and educational technology levy;
 - e. An amount equal to that raised by the district's 2012 alternative education program levy; and
 - f. An amount equal to <u>sixty-five percent of all</u>:
 - (1) Seventy-five percent of all revenue Revenue received by the school district and reported under code 2000 of the North Dakota school district financial

3	(2)	Seventy-five percent of all mineral Mineral revenue received by the school

2		of revenue received specifically for the operation of an educational program

5	(4)	Seventy-five percent of all revenue Revenue received by the school district
6		from payments in lieu of taxes on the distribution and transmission of
7		electric power;
8	(5)	Seventy-five percent of all revenue Revenue received by the school district
9		from payments in lieu of taxes on electricity generated from sources other
20		than coal;
21	(6)	All revenue Revenue received by the school district from mobile home taxes
22	(7)	Seventy-five percent of all revenue Revenue received by the school district
23		from the leasing of land acquired by the United States for which
24		compensation is allocated to the state under 33 U.S.C. 701(c)(3);
25	(8)	All telecommunications Telecommunications tax revenue received by the
26		school district; and
27	(9)	All revenue Revenue received by the school district from payments in lieu of
28		taxes and state reimbursement of the homestead credit and disabled
29		veterans credit.

1 The superintendent shall divide the district's total baseline funding by the district's 2 2012-13 weighted student units to determine the district's baseline funding per 3 weighted student unit. 4 3. In 2017-18, the superintendent shall multiply the district's weighted student units 5 by nine thousand six hundred forty-six dollars. 6 The superintendent shall adjust the product to ensure the product is at least 7 equal to the greater of: 8 One hundred eight percent of the district's baseline funding per 9 weighted student unit, as established in subsection 2, multiplied by 10 the district's weighted student units from the previous school year; or 11 (b) One hundred percent of the district's baseline funding as established 12 in subsection 1. 13 (2) The superintendent also shall adjust the product to ensure the product does 14 not exceed one hundred forty percent of the district's baseline funding per 15 weighted student unit multiplied by the district's weighted student units from 16 the previous school year, as established in subsection 2. 17 b. In 2018-19, the superintendent shall multiply the district's weighted student units 18 by nine thousand six hundred forty-six dollars. 19 The superintendent shall adjust the product to ensure the product is at least 20 equal to the greater of: 21 (a) One hundred eight percent of the district's baseline funding per 22 weighted student unit, as established in subsection 2, multiplied by 23 the district's weighted student units from the previous school year; or 24 (b) One hundred percent of the district's baseline funding as established 25 in subsection 1. 26 (2) The superintendent also shall adjust the product to ensure the product does 27 not exceed one hundred forty percent of the district's baseline funding per 28 weighted student unit, as established in subsection 2, multiplied by the 29 district's weighted student units from the previous school year. 30 4. After determining the product in accordance with subsection 3, the superintendent of 31 public instruction shall:

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- Subtract an amount equal to sixty mills multiplied by the taxable valuation of the school district, except the amount in dollars subtracted for purposes of this 3 subdivision may not exceed the previous year's amount in dollars subtracted for purposes of this subdivision by more than twelve percent; and
 - Subtract an amount equal to seventy-five percent of all revenues listed b. in paragraphs 1 through 5, and 7 of subdivision f of subsection 1 and one hundred percent of all revenues listed in paragraphs 6, 8, and 9 of subdivision f of subsection 1.
 - 5. The amount remaining after the computation required under subsection 4 is the amount of state aid to which a school district is entitled, subject to any other statutory requirements or limitations.
