## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1298

Page 1, line 1, after "A BILL" replace the remainder of the bill with "for an Act to provide for a legislative management study concerning the accessibility of the state capitol.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - ACCESSIBILITY OF THE STATE CAPITOL. During the 2019-20 interim, the legislative management shall consider studying the accessibility of the state capitol grounds as related to the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 [104 Stat. 327; 42 U.S.C. 12101 et seq.]. The study must include the effectiveness of the quantity and location of handicapped accessible parking spaces and the accessibility of entrances to the capitol in consideration of security concerns. The study also must include interior considerations including handicapped accessible restrooms with appropriate signage and seating areas on the ground floor of the capitol for individuals to rest. The legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-seventh legislative assembly."
