- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 39-10 and a new subdivision to
- 2 subsection 2 of section 39-06.1-06 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to prohibiting
- 3 blocking parking spaces for electric vehicles; and to provide a penalty.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 39-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

## Electric vehicle parking stalls or spaces - Unauthorized parking or obstructing.

- If a public or private entity designates a parking space for charging an electric vehicle, the reserved space must be indicated by a sign approved by the director. The sign must be consistent with the manual of uniform traffic control devices authorized under section 39-13-06, and indicate:
  - a. Use of the reserved space is for charging electric vehicles only; and
  - b. Unauthorized use of the spaces is a nonmoving violation for which a fee of fifty dollars must be imposed.
- An individual may not park or leave standing a vehicle in a stall or space designated
  for charging and parking a vehicle, unless the individual's vehicle is connected for
  electric charging purposes.
- 2.3. An individual may not obstruct, block, or otherwise bar access to a parking stall or space designated for charging and parking a vehicle.
- **SECTION 2.** A new subdivision to subsection 2 of section 39-06.1-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- A violation of section 1 of this Act, a fee of one hundred fifty dollars.
