- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new chapter to title 4.1 of the North Dakota Century
- 2 Code, relating to the agricultural products utilization commission; to repeal chapter 54-60.3 of

3 the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the agricultural products utilization commission; and

4 to provide a report.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 **SECTION 1.** A new chapter to title 4.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and 7 enacted as follows:

8 Agricultural products utilization commission - Composition - Appointment.

9 <u>The agricultural products utilization commission shall administer the agricultural products</u>

10 <u>utilization fund. The commission shall consist of nine members, five of whom must be appointed</u>

11 by the governor agriculture commissioner for terms of two years each, arranged so that two

12 terms expire in odd-numbered years and three terms expire in even-numbered years.

13 <u>ThreeFour members appointed by the governoragriculture commissioner must be actively</u>

14 engaged in farming in this state and two members one member appointed by the

15 governor agriculture commissioner must be actively engaged in business in this state. The

16 agriculture commissioner governor shall appoint one member for a term of two years which

17 expires in odd-numbered years. The member appointed by the commissioner governor must be

18 <u>actively engaged in farmingbusiness in this state. Commission members may be reappointed.</u>

19 <u>Terms of commissioners commence on the first day of July. The commissioner of commerce,</u>

20 the president of North Dakota state university, and the agriculture commissioner, or their

21 designees, are members of the commission. The commission shall elect one of its members as

22 <u>chairman.</u>

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1	<u>Agr</u>	ricultural products utilization commission - Authority.
2	<u>1.</u>	The North Dakota agricultural products utilization commission may apply for, accept,
3		and expend any appropriation, grant, gift, or service made available from public or
4		private sources.
5	<u>2.</u>	The commission may administer grant programs including:
6		a. A basic and applied research grant program;
7		b. A utilization and marketing grant program;
8		c. A cooperative marketing grant program;
9		d. <u>A nature-based tourism grant program;</u>
10		e. <u>A technical assistance grant program for value-added businesses;</u>
11		f. <u>A farm diversification grant program;</u>
12		g. An agricultural prototype development grant program;
13		h. An agricultural technologies grant program; and
14		i. A North American marketing grant program.
15	<u>3.</u>	As a condition of any grant administered by the commission, the commission may
16		require the recipient repay some or all of the grant if the recipient does not fulfill the
17		conditions of the grant. Repayment may be monetary or any other type or method
18		determined by the commission.
19	<u>Agr</u>	ricultural products utilization commission - Meetings - Personnel - Reports.
20	<u>The</u>	e agricultural products utilization commission, an office of the agriculture commissioner,
21	shall me	eet as necessary and shall report to each session of the legislative assembly. The
22	<u>commis</u>	sion may secure commissioner shall provide office space, employ required personnel for
23	the perf	formance of its duties, hire consultants, spend any funds appropriated to the
24	<u>commis</u>	ssion, and contract with public entities or private parties for services.
25	<u>Agr</u>	ricultural products utilization commission - Reimbursement - Compensation.
26	<u>Mer</u>	mbers of the agricultural products utilization commission are entitled to be reimbursed
27	for expe	enses incurred in the performance of their duties, in the same manner as other state
28	officials	are reimbursed, according to sections 44-08-04 and 54-06-09. If not otherwise
29	employe	ed by the state of North Dakota, members of the commission are entitled to receive per
30	diem co	ompensation of one hundred thirty-five dollars for each day of attending meetings and
31	perform	ning other duties relating to official business of the commission. The commission

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- 1 chairman, if not otherwise employed by the state of North Dakota, may receive an additional
- 2 one hundred dollars for each day of a regular meeting attended as payment for reviewing and
- 3 evaluating grant proposals.

4 Agricultural products utilization commission - Administrative expenses.

- 5 <u>Administrative expenses of the agricultural products utilization commission, including</u>
- 6 expenses of members of the commission, employment of required personnel, hiring of
- 7 consultants, and contracting with public or private entities for services may not exceed ten
- 8 percent of the funds appropriated to the commission by the legislative assembly each biennium,
- 9 excluding federal funds.

10 Agricultural products utilization fund - Purposes.

- 11 The agricultural products utilization fund in the state treasury must be used to fund
- 12 programs for agricultural research, development, processing, technology, and marketing. The
- 13 fund must be used to defray the expenses of the North Dakota agricultural products utilization
- 14 commission. Interest earned on moneys in the fund must be credited to the fund.
- 15 **SECTION 2. REPEAL.** Chapter 54-60.3 of the North Dakota Century Code is repealed.
