1 A concurrent resolution to amend and reenact section 9 of article III and section 16 of article IV 2 of the Constitution of North Dakota, relating to initiated measures for constitutional 3 amendments. 4 STATEMENT OF INTENT 5 This measure would require at least fifty-five percent of the members of each house of the 6 legislative assembly to approve a constitutional amendment to be placed on the ballot at the 7 next general election. This measure would increase the votes required to approve an initiated-8 measure for a constitutional amendment from a simple majority to sixty at least fifty-five percent 9 of votes cast. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE 10 11 **SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:** 12 That the following proposed amendmentamendments to section 9 of article III and 13 section 16 of article IV of the Constitution of North Dakota is agreed to and must be submitted 14 to the qualified electors of North Dakota at the general election to be held in 2020 in accordance 15 with section 16 of article IV of the Constitution of North Dakota. 16 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 9 of article III of the Constitution of North Dakota is 17 amended and reenacted as follows: 18 Section 9. A constitutional amendment may be proposed by initiative petition. If signed by 19 electors equal in number to four percent of the resident population of the state at the last federal 20 decennial census, the petition may be submitted to the secretary of state. An initiated measure 21 to amend the constitution may be placed on the ballot only at a general election. If at least 22 sixty fifty-five percent of votes cast on an initiated measure for a constitutional amendment are 23 affirmative, the amendment is deemed enacted. All other provisions relating to initiative 24 measures apply hereto to constitutional amendments proposed by initiative petition.

Section 16. Any amendment to this constitution may be proposed in either house of the legislative assembly, and if agreed to upon a roll call by a majorityat least fifty-five percent of the members elected to each house, must be submitted to the electors and if a majorityat the following general election. If at least fifty-five percent of the votes cast thereonon the constitutional amendment are in the affirmative, the amendment is a part of this constitution.
