PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO REENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2030

That the House recede from its amendments as printed on pages 1218-1220 of the Senate Journal and pages 1431-1433 of the House Journal and that Engrossed Senate Bill No. 2030 be amended as follows:

- Page 1, line 2, remove "to create and enact paragraph 3 of"
- Page 1, remove lines 3 and 4
- Page 1, line 5, remove "eligibility for a matching grant for the advancement of academics; and"
- Page 1, line 6, remove ", subdivision a of subsection 1 of section"
- Page 1, line 7, replace the first "15-10-49," with "and"
- Page 1, line 7, remove ", and subdivision a of subsection 2"
- Page 1, line 8, remove "of section 15-10-49"
- Page 1, line 9, after "academics" insert "; to repeal subdivision d of subsection 1 of section 15-10-48 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the eligibility of the university of North Dakota school of medicine and health sciences to receive matching grants for the advancement of academics; and to provide for a legislative management study"
- Page 1, remove lines 17 through 24
- Page 2, remove lines 1 and 2
- Page 2, line 6, overstrike "to"
- Page 2, line 6, overstrike "institution" and insert immediately thereafter "to the university of North Dakota and North Dakota state university; and up to one million five hundred thousand dollars in matching grants for projects at the university of North Dakota school of medicine and health sciences"
- Page 2, remove lines 7 through 29
- Page 3, line 8, remove "university of Jamestown,"
- Page 3, line 8, remove the second "university"
- Page 3, line 9, remove "of Mary,"
- Page 3, replace lines 10 through 15 with:

"SECTION 4. REPEAL. Subdivision d of subsection 1 of section 15-10-48 of the North Dakota Century Code is repealed.

SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - IMPACT OF ABORTION-RELATED RESTRICTIONS ON HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS.

During the 2021-22 interim, the legislative management shall consider studying the potential impact of legal restrictions relating to abortion for institutions under the control of the state board of higher education. The study must include:

- The impact of potential laws preventing institutions of higher education from sponsoring, partnering with, applying for grants with, or providing a grant subaward to any person or organization that performs or promotes the performance of an abortion unless the abortion is necessary to prevent the death of the woman, or from participating in or sponsoring any program producing, distributing, publishing, disseminating, endorsing, or approving materials of any type or from any organization which, between normal childbirth and abortion, do not give preference, encouragement, and support to normal childbirth.
- 2. The potential impacts of the restrictions included in subsection 1 and chapter 14-02.3 on accreditation, academic programs, research, internships, donations, and other institution operations.
- 3. The potential conflicts between section 15-10.4-02 and the restrictions included in subsection 1 and chapter 14-02.3, including conflicts with academic freedom, free speech, activities of student organizations, and the use of state funds by student organizations."
