RE: (SB 2018) Amendment relating to UAS training

Chairman Monson and Members of the Committee,

I am writing on behalf of the Williston Economic Development office to express our full support of Senate Bill 2018 specifically the amendment that dedicates grant funding for expanding workforce opportunities, training and education related to the beyond visual line of sight UAS industry.

The introduction of the Vantis network into Western North Dakota provides the area prime opportunities on two facets: The ability to reduce costs and increase efficiencies within the oil and gas industry and the introduction of a diversified industry to limit the ups and downs related to an economy dependent on commodity prices.
