<b>Conclusions:</b>						
<b>Sales tax is the largest State General Fund revenue source, contributing 36.1% of the total biennial SGF revenue (thru 12/2020)</b>						
<b>Businesses within the largest 50 cities remit 53.4% of the sales tax revenue</b>						
<b>Businesses within smaller cities remit 4.0% of the sales tax revenue</b>						
<b>Therefore, businesses within ALL (in-state) cities remit 57.4% of the sales tax revenue</b>						
<b>Based in their businesses' contributions to total taxable sales and purchases, businesses located within the state's cities remit 20.7% of total State General Fund Revenues</b>
