

HB 1479 – Testimony by Dustin Gawrylow (Lobbyist #266) North Dakota Watchdog Network

We have long supported any and all efforts to flatten and lower North Dakota’s income tax rate.

By exempting a large amount of income at the bottom end of the scale, the approach in HB 1479 ensures that essentially the bottom 1/3 of income earners pay no state tax – and everyone else pays the lowest rate in the country among those states that still have income tax.

As personal income tax rates are applied to LLCs, we can also make up ground in that area where we rank 17th (which has improved from the 33rd place we were in back when I started lobbying for taxpayers in 2009).
