-section 3 would include in the grants, gitts, and donations line item \$100,000 received by the Game and Fish Department for surface damage, easements, or reclamation on department-owned or department-managed properties from oil or mining activities.

Section 4 would authorize the Game and Fish Department to transfer up to 10 percent of the agency's total appropriation between line items, excluding salaries and wages, during the 2021-23 biennium. The department must report transfers to the Office of Management and Budget and the Legislative Council.
