FEDERAL CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND - ESTIMATED UNSPENT AUTHORITY

In March 2020, Congress approved, and the President signed, United States House of Representatives Bill No. 748, also known as the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act. The bill included a \$150 billion Coronavirus Relief Fund (CRF) to be allocated to states to pay for Coronavirus (COVID-19) costs that are:

- 1. Necessary due to the COVID-19 pandemic;
- 2. Were not accounted for in the most recently approved budget; and
- 3. Were incurred during the period March 1, 2020, through December 30, 2020.

United States House of Representatives Bill No. 133, which was approved in December 2020, extended the deadline to use CRF funding to December 31, 2021.

North Dakota received a \$1.25 billion allocation from the CRF. During the 2019-20 interim, the Emergency Commission and Budget Section allocated the entire \$1.25 billion to state agencies and political subdivisions. The schedule below details the CRF allocations to each agency and the estimated amount of unspent and unobligated CRF funding ("turnback") for each agency as of June 30, 2021.

INTEREST ON CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUNDING

Interest earned on any federal coronavirus relief funding held by the state may not be transferred to the general fund and may be used only for items eligible to be paid with federal coronavirus relief funding. Through February 2021, a total of \$505,823 of interest has accrued on the federal coronavirus relief funds and is available for allocation.
