### Section 1. APPROPRIATION.

### "SECTION 6. EXEMPTION - ENHANCED STATE HIGHWAY INVESTMENT FUNDING.

Section 54-44.1-11 does not apply to the remaining \$26,200,669 of the \$503,115,558 in the capital assets line item relating to enhanced state highway investments in section 1 of chapter 12 of the 2015 Session Laws and any unexpended funds must be continued into the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023 July 1, 2023, and ending June 30 2025, and may be expended only for enhanced state highway investments.
