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## INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY UNIFICATION FTE POSITIONS AND EXPENDITURE ADJUSTMENTS

This memorandum provides information regarding the information technology unification initiative approved for the 2019-21 biennium and the recommendations included in the executive budget for the 2021-23 biennium. As detailed in the schedule below, the 2021-23 executive budget recommendation includes increases (decreases) to salaries and wages, operating expenses, and other expenditures and the transfer of 66 full-time equivalent (FTE) positions from 10 agencies to the Information Technology Department.

## 2019-21 Biennium Information Technology Unification Initiative

The 2019 Legislative Assembly authorized an information technology unification initiative for the 2019-21 biennium, which included the transfer of 96 FTE positions from five agencies to the Information Technology Department, as a pilot project to consolidate information technology resources in state government as follows:

<sup>1</sup>Of the 16 FTE positions recommended to be transferred from Job Service North Dakota to the Information Technology Department, 6 FTE positions were unfunded in previous bienniums. The executive budget recommendations include providing federal funds spending authority in Job Service North Dakota's operating expenses line item for Job Service North Dakota to pay the Information Technology Department for the use of these FTE positions if federal funding becomes available.

If approved, the governor's recommendation for information technology unification would result in a total of 162 FTE positions transferred to the Information Technology Department from 15 agencies during the 2019-21 and 2021-23 bienniums.

After the Governor's recommendation was finalized, the Insurance Commissioner and the Retirement and Investment Office requested the Information Technology Department to consider including these agencies in any information technology unification initiative approved for the 2021-23 biennium. The Insurance Commissioner has 1 FTE information technology position and the Retirement and Investment Office has 2 FTE information technology positions. If approved, a total of 165 FTE positions would be transferred to the Information Technology Department from 17 agencies during the 2019-21 and 2021-23 bienniums.
