- The study must include a review of the following:

 but do not meet the eligibility criteria for existing programs;
 - Gap identification with programmatic recommendations, identifying potential strategies to address these gaps, and potential federal and state funding sources;
 - Efforts and services offered by other states, including the planning and implementation process for any new programs;
 and
 - d. The impact of implementation and expanding of programs to address service gaps, including the number of individuals impacted, cost, and timeline for implementation.
- The legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation necessary to implement those recommendations, to the sixty-eighth legislative assembly.
- 3. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriate, the sum of \$150,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of human services for the purpose of selecting a consultant to assist legislative

management in its study, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023."
