Testimony of Travis W. Finck, Executive Director, NDCLCI

Madam Chair Larson, members of the Senate Judiciary Committee, my name is Travis
Finck and I am the executive director for the North Dakota Commission on Legal Counsel for
Indigents. The Commission is the state agency responsible for the delivery of indigent defense
services in North Dakota. I rise today on behalf of the Commission to provide testimony in
support of SB 2246.

The Commission supports the establishment of evidence based alternative courts as pathways for recovery. The establishment of a veteran's court docket serves as a model to serve and protect those who have served and protected. Furthermore, evidence suggests the use of veteran's court has had success in diverting individuals from prison and back to productive members of society.

Madam Chair, on behalf of the Commission on Legal Counsel for Indigents, we urge a do pass recommendation.
