Mr. Wolf,

I have been listening to the Senate Transportation Committee and I heard members of the committee discussing the concern with the current wording of 39-29-09 subsection 9 relating to helmets for operators and riders 17 and younger. There is no requirement for any individual to wear a helmet while they are operating on private property. This is covered in the first sentence of 39-29-09 subsection 1 which states "An individual may not operate an off-highway vehicle on the roadway, shoulder, or inside bank or slope of any road, street, or highway except as provided in this CHAPTER." Since the word "Chapter" is in this sentence it means that the wearing of a helmet is only required on the areas listed within the sentence. The sentence does not include private property so the helmet law under 39-39-09 (9) does not apply to private property. I hope this information is beneficial to the committee.
