- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 15.1-21-17.1 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to interim assessment of students.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** Section 15.1-21-17.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and

5 enacted as follows:

6	<u>15.1</u>	-21-17.1. Interim assessment - State-provided or state-approved list.
7	<u>1.</u>	Each public school district shall administer annually to students in grades kindergarten
8		through ten at least two assessments in mathematics and reading. In administering

- 9 <u>the assessment, a public school district shall use:</u>
- 10 <u>a.</u> <u>The state-provided interim assessment; or</u>
- 11b.An interim assessment from a state-approved list created and maintained by the12superintendent of public instruction.
- 13 <u>2.</u> <u>The superintendent of public instruction shall contract with an interim assessment</u>
- 14 <u>vendor to create a state-provided interim assessment and distribute the assessment to</u>

15 <u>each public school district, at no charge to the districts, for the grade levels and</u>

- 16 <u>subjects provided in subsection 1.</u>
- 17 <u>3.</u> If a district chooses to use an assessment from the state-approved list, the district is
 18 responsible for any assessment-related costs.
- 19 <u>4.</u> <u>To qualify as a state-provided or state-approved vendor of interim assessments, a</u>
- 20 vendor must share the assessment data electronically with the statewide longitudinal
- 21 <u>data system for the purposes of statewide aggregated data results. Individual district</u>
- 22 level data may be shared at the discretion of the local district.
- 5. The superintendent shall adopt rules to develop the selection and approval criteria for
 a state-approved interim assessment vendor.
