A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 29-04-03.3 of the North Dakota Century Code,
relating to the statute of limitations for prosecuting sex crimes involving victims who develop a
disabling mental condition; and to provide a penalty for an Act to amend and reenact section
29-04-02.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to prosecution for gross sexual
imposition; and to provide a penalty.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

7 SECTION 1. Section 29-04-03.3 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted 8 as follows: 9 29-04-03.3. Statute of limitations for victim with disabling mental condition. 10 As used in this section: 11 "Disabling mental condition" means a psychological disorder that significantly 12 decreases, impairs, or interferes with an individual's cognition, emotional 13 regulation, or behavior. The term includes depression and posttraumatic stress 14 disorder. 15 "Mental health provider" means a licensed physician, psychologist, therapist, 16 psychiatrist, mental health counselor, or addiction counselor, who completed a 17 professional assessment to determine the validity of the victim's disabling mental-18 condition and provided the victim with behavioral health services for the victim's 19 disabling mental condition. 20 <u>A prosecution for a violation of sections 12.1-20-03, 12.1-20-04, 12.1-20-06,</u> 21 12.1-20-06.1, 12.1-20-07, 12.1-20-11, 12.1-20-12.3, or for the crime of human 22 trafficking, must be commenced in the proper court within two years after the victim no-23 longer has a disabling mental condition if:

commenced in the proper court within seven years after the commission of the offense.
