- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to high-demand certificates scholarships; and to provide an
- 3 appropriation.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
6 and enacted as follows:

7 <u>High-demand certificates scholarship.</u>

- 8 <u>1.</u> The state board of higher education shall adopt policies and procedures to develop,
 9 implement, promote, and administer a high-demand certificates scholarship program
 10 to encourage residents of the state to enroll in educational programs for commercial
- 11 driver's license and certified nursing assistant certificates.
- 12 <u>2.</u> <u>Individuals enrolled in a qualifying educational program with a physical presence in</u>
- 13 this state may apply for a scholarship under this section. Eligible applicants must be
- 14 enrolled in a commercial driver's license or certified nursing assistant program at an
- accredited institution or other program approved by the board of career and technical
 education.
- 17 <u>3.</u> <u>Subject to legislative appropriations, eligible applicants may be awarded up to five</u>
- 18 hundred dollars to assist the student with the costs of completing a qualifying certified
- 19 <u>nursing assistant educational program and up to one thousand five hundred dollars to</u>
- assist the student with the costs of completing a qualifying commercial driver's license
 educational program.
- 22 4. The state board of higher education shall distribute grants to the accredited institution
 23 or other program approved by the board of career and technical education to provide

- 1 the amounts necessary for the scholarships awarded to the students enrolled in each
- 2 <u>institution or program.</u>
- 3 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION STATE BOARD OF HIGHER EDUCATION HIGH-
- 4 **DEMAND CERTIFICATES SCHOLARSHIP.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the
- 5 general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$1,000,000, or so
- 6 much of the sum as may be necessary, to the state board of higher education for the purpose of
- 7 providing financial assistance to students eligible for the high-demand certificates scholarship
- 8 program, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2025.
