3	<u>2.</u>	For purposes of this section, an individual who is a public servant acts under color of
4		the individual's office or employment if the individual acts or purports to act in an
5		official capacity or takes advantage of such actual or purported capacity.
6	<u>3.</u>	For purposes of this section, "public servant" includes:
7		a. An officer, employee, or agent of the United States or a branch, department, or
8		agency of the United States;
9		b. An individual acting under contract with a branch, department, or agency of the
10		United States for the purpose of providing security or law enforcement; and
11		c. An individual acting under color of federal law.
