

**FIRST ENGROSSMENT
with Senate Amendments
ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1025**

Introduced by

Appropriations Committee

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the department of
2 veterans' affairs; and to provide an exemption.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds
5 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
6 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and
7 other income, to the department of veterans' affairs for the purpose of defraying the expenses of
8 the department of veterans' affairs, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, and ending
9 June 30, 2025, as follows:

22 **SECTION 2. ONE-TIME FUNDING - EFFECT ON BASE BUDGET - REPORT TO**

23 **SIXTY-NINTH LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY.** The following amounts reflect the one-time funding

1 items approved by the sixty-seventh legislative assembly for the 2021-23 biennium and the
2 one-time funding items included in the appropriation in section 1 of this Act:

12 The 2023-25 biennium one-time funding amounts are not a part of the entity's base budget
13 for the 2025-27 biennium. The department of veterans' affairs shall report to the appropriations
14 committees of the sixty-ninth legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the
15 biennium beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2025.

16 **SECTION 3. ESTIMATED INCOME - FEDERAL STATE FISCAL RECOVERY FUND -**

17 **DOCUMENT SCANNING PROJECT.** The estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act
18 includes the sum of \$100,836 from federal funds derived from the state fiscal recovery fund for
19 the purpose of a document scanning project.

20 **SECTION 4. EXEMPTION - POSTTRAUMATIC STRESS DISORDER SERVICE DOG**

21 **PROGRAM.** The \$50,000 appropriated from the general fund for the posttraumatic stress
22 disorder service dog program in section 1 of chapter 25 of the 2019 Session Laws and the
23 \$50,000 appropriated from the general fund for the posttraumatic stress disorder service dog
24 program in section 1 of chapter 53 of the 2021 Session Laws is not subject to section
25 54-44.1-11 and any unspent funds from this program are available for the program during the
26 biennium beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2025.

27 **SECTION 5. EXEMPTION - FEDERAL STATE FISCAL RECOVERY FUND.** The \$647,000
28 appropriated from the federal state fiscal recovery fund in subsections 32 and 33 of section 1 of
29 chapter 550 of the 2021 Session Laws, of which \$500,000 was for a grant to assist in the
30 construction of the Fisher house at the Fargo veterans' affairs medical center and \$147,000 was
31 for improving and expanding veterans' medical transportation, is not subject to section

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1 54-44.1-11 and any unspent funds from these programs are available for the programs during
2 the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2025. Of the \$147,000 for veterans'
3 medical transportation, \$18,800 may be used for the purchase of a nonhighly rural transport van
4 during the 2023-25 biennium.
