PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2238

That the House recede from its amendments as printed on page 1071 of the Senate Journal and page 1230 of the House Journal and that Engrossed Senate Bill No. 2238 be amended as follows:

Page 1, line 2, remove "and"

Page 1, line 3, after "study" insert "; and to provide an appropriation"

Page 3, after line 6, insert:

"SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES - CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD CHECKS. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$300,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of health and human services for the purpose of salary and wages for personnel to process fingerprints and complete required criminal history record checks and for the purchase of two fingerprint scanners, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2025. The department is authorized two full-time equivalent positions to process fingerprints for criminal history record checks."
