- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 37-18 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to reimbursement for funeral services; and to provide an appropriation.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 37-18 of the North Dakota Century Code is created

5 and enacted as follows:

6 Veterans' service organization reimbursement.

- 7 <u>1.</u> <u>The department shall administer a program to reimburse a veterans' service</u>
- 8 organization for providing a funeral service at a military honors funeral.
- 9 <u>2.</u> Upon the request of a veterans' service organization, the department shall reimburse
- 10 <u>up to fifty dollars to one veterans' service organization per funeral for providing a</u>
- 11 <u>funeral service during a military honors funeral. If a veterans' service organization has</u>
- 12 received federal reimbursement for providing a funeral service for a military honors
- 13 <u>funeral, the veterans' service organization may not apply for reimbursement under this</u>
 14 section.
- 15 <u>3.</u> <u>The veterans' service organization may authorize the playing of taps on a ceremonial</u>
- bugle or a high-quality recording during a military honors funeral held in this state for a
 deceased veteran.
- 18 <u>4.</u> <u>As used in this section, a "funeral service" includes a:</u>
- 19 <u>a.</u> Folding of the flag;
- 20 <u>b.</u> <u>Presentation of the flag;</u>
- 21 <u>c.</u> <u>Presentation of the state coin;</u>
- 22 <u>d.</u> <u>Playing of taps; and</u>
- 23 <u>e.</u> <u>Three volley salute.</u>

1 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS' AFFAIRS - FUNERAL

- 2 **SERVICE REIMBURSEMENT.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in
- 3 the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$135,000, or so much of the sum as
- 4 may be necessary, to the department of veterans' affairs for the purpose of providing
- 5 reimbursement to a veterans' service organization that provides a funeral service under
- 6 section 1 of this Act, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2025.
