- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 4 of section 11-11-14 of the North Dakota Century
 Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- To control the finances, to contract debts and borrow money, to make payments of
 debts and expenses, to establish charges for any county or other services, and to
 control the property of the county, and to contract for cooperative purchases pursuant
- to a joint-powers agreement under chapter 54-40.3.
- SECTION 2. A new section to chapter 11-11 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 15 <u>Cooperative purchasing Authorized.</u>
- With the approval of the board of county commissioners, a county may participate in
- 17 cooperative purchasing agreements with the state, or another political subdivision of this state
- or any other state, by executing a joint-powers agreement under chapter 54-40.3.
- 19 **SECTION 3. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 52 of section 40-05-01 of the North Dakota
- 20 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 52. Supplies. To provide that supplies needed for the use of the municipality shall city be
