- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15.1-09-33.1 of the North Dakota Century
- 2 Code, relating to the authority of a school district to pay signing bonuses.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15.1-09-33.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **15.1-09-33.1. School board authority - Payment of signing bonuses.**

- The board of a school district may offer and, upon the signing of the contract by both
 parties, pay a signing bonus to an individual who:
- 9 a. Is licensed to teach by the education standards and practices board or approved
 10 to teach by the education standards and practices board;
- b. Has signed a contract of employment to serve as a classroom teacher in the
 district; and
- c. Was not<u>Has never been</u> employed as a classroom teacherin the newly-assigned
 role by the board of a school district in this state during the previous school year.
- 15 2. The board may pay to the individual the signing bonus authorized by subsection 1 in:
- 16 a. One lump sum upon the individual signing a contract of employment; or
- b. Installments over a period of time not to exceed three<u>five</u> years from the date the
 individual signed a contract of employment.
- 19 3. A signing bonus paid under this section:
- 20 a. Is in addition to any amount payable under a negotiated teachers' contract;.
- b. May not be included in the district's negotiated salary schedule; and.
- 22 c. May not be included as salary for continuing contract purposes.
- 23 <u>d.</u> <u>May not be paid until the individual is licensed and qualified for the</u>
- 24 <u>newly-assigned role by the education standards and practices board.</u>

1e.May not be used for an individual employed the prior year by another school2district in the state until the individual has been employed in the district for3two years.
