BILL DESCRIPTION: Exclusion for Athletes in Contact Sports from Definition of Employee

SUMMARY OF ACTUARIAL INFORMATION: Workforce Safety & Insurance, together with its consulting actuaries, The Burkhalter Group, has reviewed the legislation proposed in this bill in conformance with Section 54-03-25 of the North Dakota Century Code.

The proposed legislation excludes athletes in contact sports from the definition of employee. Employers of athletes in contact sports would no longer be required to obtain workers compensation coverage for their athlete employees.

FISCAL IMPACT: Workers compensation coverage for athletes in contact sports would no longer be required resulting in no premium assessments or losses arising from this employee class.
