- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 23-01 and a new section to
- 2 chapter 32-12.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to studying vaccines and the
- 3 medical liability of a governmental entity.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 23-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Vaccine study - Liability.

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- 8 <u>1. The department of health and human services shall study and maintain records on the</u>
- 9 <u>effects of any vaccine intended to develop an immune system response to</u>
- 10 SARS-CoV-2 and any mutation or viral fragments of SARS-CoV-2. The study must
- 11 <u>include research on individuals who died thirty days after receiving the vaccine.</u>
- 12 <u>2. If the department of health and human services promotes, markets, or advertises any </u>
- 13 <u>messenger ribonucleic acid vaccine or any vaccine intended to develop an immune</u>
- system response to SARS-CoV-2 and any mutation or viral fragments of
- 15 SARS-CoV-2, the department shall cover the costs of treatment and diagnostics for
- any individual who suffers any physical injury due to receiving the vaccine.
- SECTION 2. A new section to chapter 32-12.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

19 <u>Medical liability of government entity.</u>

- 20 <u>1. As used in this section, "medical product" means any product used to diagnose or</u>
- 21 <u>manage a disease, including any medical device, treatment, or drug.</u>
- 22 <u>2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a state agency, political subdivision, or any </u>
- 23 <u>other governmental entity, may not require an individual to take, receive, or disclose</u>
- 24 whether the individual has taken or received a medical product unless the

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- 1 <u>manufacturer of the medical product is liable for any death or serious injury caused by</u>
- 2 <u>the medical product.</u>
- 3 <u>3. Subsection 2 does not apply to a public hospital.</u>
