- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-06 and a new section to
- 2 chapter 54-44.4 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to contracts with companies that
- 3 boycott Israel and a prohibition on investments.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 54-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

<u>Investments - Prohibition - Israel boycott.</u>

- 1. As used in this section "boycott Israel" means engaging in refusals to deal, terminating business activities, or other similar commercial actions intended to limit commercial relations with persons doing business in Israel or in Israeli-controlled territories when the actions are taken:
 - a. In compliance or adherence to calls for a boycott of Israel, other than those boycotts under Public Law No. 96-72 [50 U.S.C. 2407(c)]; or
 - b. In a manner that discriminates on the basis of nationality, national origin, or religion.
 - 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the state may not adopt any investment policy that would have the effect of requiring or inducing any person to boycott Israel.
 - 3. For purposes of determining whether a company boycotts Israel, a company statement that it is participating in boycotts of Israel or that it has taken the boycott action at the request, in compliance with, or in furtherance of calls for a boycott of Israel, can be considered as one type of evidence that a company is participating in a boycott of Israel when accompanied with the conduct described under subsection 1.
 An expressive activity directed at a specific person or a governmental action may not be considered evidence of a boycott of Israel.

17	<u>2.</u>	A state entity that enters a contract that includes a provision prohibiting discrimination			
18		shall require the contract to include a provision prohibiting a party to the contract from			
19		boycotting Israel for the duration of the contract. Failure to comply with this subsection			
20		does	s not	affect the enforceability of a contract.
