- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 06-06-07 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to credit union membership.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 06-06-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

- 6 **6-06-07. Membership in credit union.**
- 7 1. The membership of a credit union consists of the incorporators and such other
- 8 persons as may be elected to membership. Each member shall subscribe to and pay
- 9 the initial installment on at least one share in the credit union and pay the entrance fee
- 10 as provided by the bylaws of the credit union. Organizations, incorporated or
- otherwise, composed principally of the same general group as the credit union
 membership may be members of the credit union.
- 13 2. Credit union membership is limited to <u>one or more</u> groups having a_{\pm}
- 14 <u>a. A</u> common bond of occupation or;
- 15 <u>b.</u> <u>A common bond of</u> association or to groups; or
- 16 A group residing, working, or attending school within a geographic area that does <u>C.</u> 17 not extend beyond a seventy-five-mile [120.70-kilometer]two-hundred-fifty-mile 18 [402.34-kilometer]one-hundred-twenty-five mile [201.17-kilometer] radius of the 19 home office of thea credit union. Except as provided by this section, an office of a 20 credit union that has a field of membership defined by geography may not be 21 located more than seventy-fiveone hundred twenty-five miles [120.70 kilometers] 22 [201.17 kilometers] from the credit union main office. The restrictions on location 23 and field of membership under this section do not apply to a credit union office 24 location or field of membership approved by the board before January 1,

1		2005 <u>August 1, 2023</u> . In the event of a merger between credit unions with different
2		geographic fields of membership, the surviving credit union may expand the field
3		of membership to include the geographic field of membership of the merged
4		credit union. After December 31, 2004, a credit union may not establish and
5	1	operate a new branch office that is outside the credit union's field of membership.
6		A branch office may not expand the geographic field of membership of a credit
7		union.
8	3.	The board shall adopt a procedure through which all interested persons, including
9		banking institutions and credit unions, are afforded reasonable opportunity to submit
10		data, views, or arguments, orally or in writing; to obtain a hearing; and to intervene as
11		a party to a proceeding concerning a proposed application for a credit union to expand
12		the credit union's field of membership.
13	<u> <u>4. </u></u>	Subject to authorization by the state credit union board, a state credit union may apply
14		for the same field of membership as a federal credit union.
