- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 14-15 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to open adoption.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 14-15 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 <u>Postadoption communication or contact agreements.</u>
- 7 <u>1. For purposes of this section, unless context requires otherwise, "birth relative"</u>
- 8 <u>includes parent, stepparent, grandparent, brother, sister, uncle, or aunt, whether by</u>
- 9 <u>blood, adoption, or marriage, of a minor child who is being adopted.</u>
- 10 <u>2.</u> An adoptive parent and a birth relative may enter an agreement regarding
- 11 <u>postadoption communication or contact between a minor adoptee, adoptive parent,</u>
- 12 and a birth relative.
- 13 3. An agreement under this section is legally enforceable if the terms of the agreement
- 14 <u>are contained in a written court order. A court may enter an order under this section</u>
- 15 <u>before a decree of adoption is granted.</u>
- 16 <u>4. Failure to comply with an order under this section is not grounds for:</u>
- 17 a. Setting aside an adoption decree; or
- 18 <u>b. Revocation of consent to adoption.</u>
- 5. An order entered under this section may be enforced by filing a petition or motion with
- 20 the court which includes a certified copy of the order and an affidavit that the parties
- 21 <u>have mediated or attempted to mediate the dispute.</u>
- 22 <u>6. The court may not modify an order under this section unless the court finds the</u>
- 23 modification is necessary to serve the best interests of the minor adoptee and:
- 24 <u>a. The modification is agreed to by the parties to the agreement; or</u>

- b. <u>Exceptional circumstances have arisen since the agreed order was entered</u>
- 2 <u>which justify modification of the order.</u>
